Yellow Hanging Station

The Retainer Ring now has a molded-in aperture disk for trapping most insects. If a larger opening is needed for use as a bait station, or for trapping pantry moths, the disk easily pops out

The standard 16 oz drink cup makes servicing a snap! Just throw it away when it gets full or dirty and use the sturdy station over and over again! Use with the appropriate InVite lure for attracting a range of pests.



Trapping Yellow Jackets, European Hornets, or Small or Large Flies: Put about 1 oz of **InVite Liquid Lure** into the cup for yellow jackets and hornets or up to 4 oz for small flies. Add water, soda, or beer (bubbles disperse

scent faster) until the cup is about 1/2 full. For house, stable and blow flies, use about 4 oz of **InVite Kill Zone** and add some water.

Other attractants may also be used.

Trapping Pantry Moths: Pop out the disk in the retainer ring. Fill the cup about 1/2 full of water and add one dose of

InVite Moth Lure Gel in the cup, above the water.

To Create a Killing Station:

Assemble the station as noted, with an appropriate attractant for the target pest. Wipe or spray the station with a microencapsulated insecticide. The target pest will then pick up the insecticide when it lands on the station.

Baiting: The PFT Station can also be used for placing poison baits for flying insects. **Pop out the inner disk of the retainer ring so that there is one large hole and put the bait in the cup. Instruction sheets are available at www.rockwelllabs.com.**

Green In-Ground Station

The Green PFT has a discreet, low profile (barely 1") when installed and is easy to place in the ground with a 2" termite station auger (with the hole reamed a bit wider at the top) or a standard bulb planter.

The included anchors secure the tamper-resistant station in the ground. The cover removes easily with no tools or special keys needed. And the sturdy cup can be quickly removed for cleaning without removing the station from the ground.



The Rugged, Economical Station for Baiting, Trapping and Monitoring Crawling Insects and Slugs

Baiting: The Green PFT is perfect for placing larger amounts (up to 12 oz!) of liquid ant bait. The unique design of the PFT dramatically minimizes evaporation, while keeping rain and dirt out. The included feeding sponge minimizes drowning and maximizes ants' use of the station. The Green PFT can also be used for granular and/or gel baits. In some instances, baiting in trees is desirable. In these cases, the PFT can be easily hung from a branch. A cord can also be tied to the rim of the station and laid over the branch, to give

ants an easy guide line to the station. *Monitoring and Trapping:* The Green PFT is ideal for monitoring insects, using the same "pitfall trap" technique entomologists have used for years. The PFT is simply put in the ground with the retainer ring pointing down, to create a funnel effect (or it can be removed altogether). An attractant is put in the cup (beer and bread is a favorite among entomologists) and crawling insects simply fall in. Beer is also a great lure to use for trapping large numbers of slugs. Outdoors, the "pitfall" method works much better than glueboards, which quickly become wet and soiled. **Instruction sheets are available at www.rockwelllabs.com.**
